PAGCOR revenues up 35% to P79.4-B in 2023

Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corp. (PAG-COR) said Friday it booked PHP79.37 billion in revenues in 2023, up 34.63 percent from 2022's PHP58.96 billion, driven mainly by robust earnings from licensed casinos and the rising Electronic Games sector.

Gaming operations remain the main source of PAGCOR revenues with PHP73 11 hillion while other sources, such as services, business income, gains, and non-operating income, contributed PHP6.26 billion.

Net income was at PHP6.81 billion, a 53.27 percent increase from the Universal Health Care agency's PHP4.44 billion profit in 2022.

PAGCOR Chairman and CEO Alejandro H. Tengco said the higher earnings enabled the state gaming firm to in-



crease its contribution to nation-building (CNB) to PHP49.56 billion, which is 43 percent higher than the PHP34.67 billion CNB in the previous year.

"Our robust revenue generation in 2023 allowed us to remit more funds to the government to finance various services, including funding for program, also known as PhilHealth." Tengco said in a news release






