

Through the Musharakah contract financing she received from the institution, she was able to expand the range of products she offered in her store.

Musharakah contract financing is a Shari-ah inspired counterpart of a regular loan. designed to help clients with existing businesses or those looking to start a new venture. Served as an additional capital, this financing is disbursed in cash to support business growth. In a Musharakah contract, both financier and the business owner contribute capital to busiing, while she worked at a ness venture, and prof-
